J'aime beaucoup Azizi parce qu'elle sourit tout le temps.



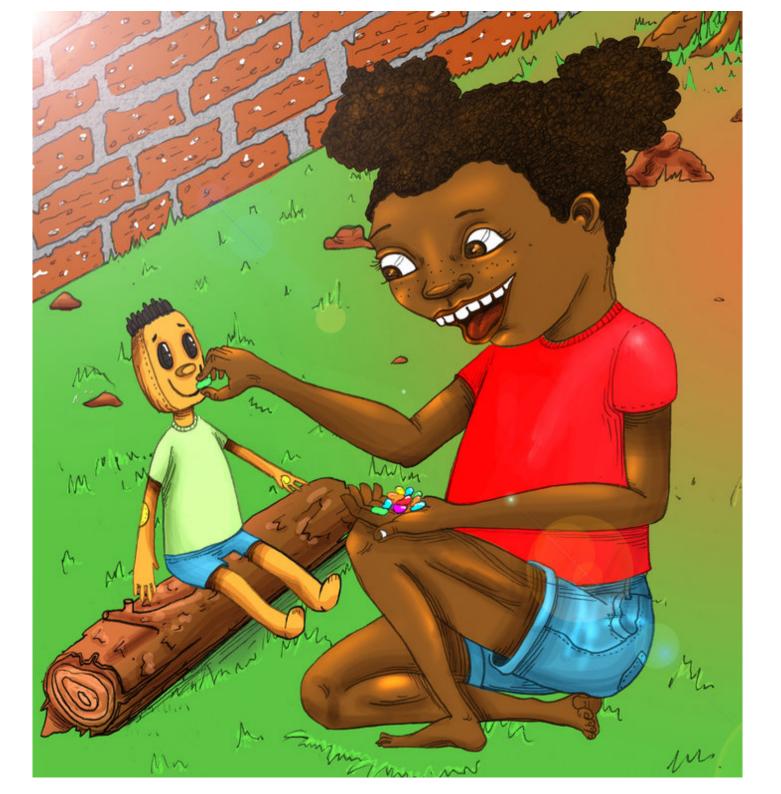
Après m'être levée, je me lave levisage. Puis je cherche Azizi.



Une fois Azizi trouvée, je lui brosse ses cheveux.



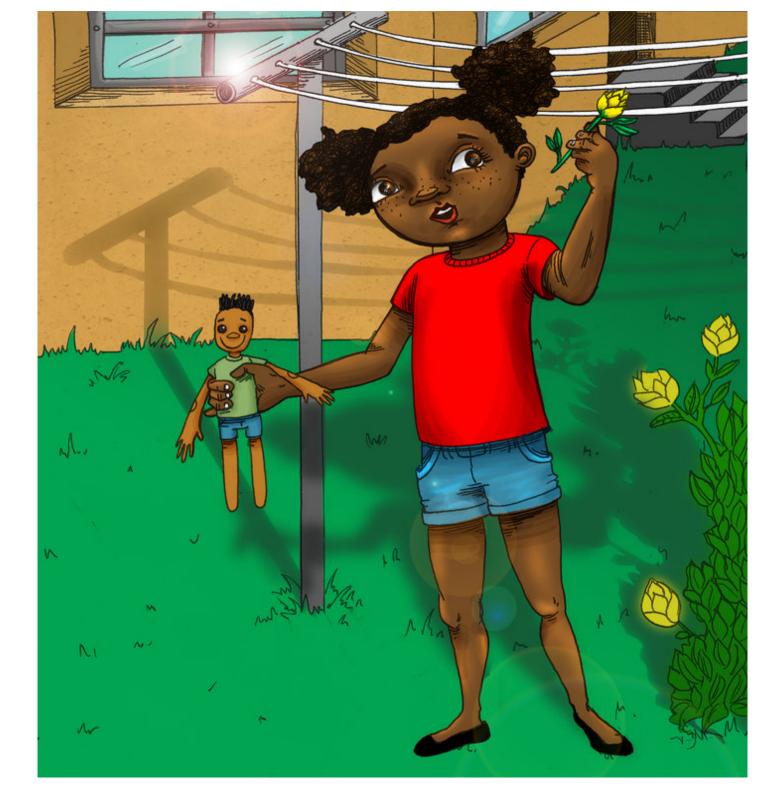
Lorsque je mange mon petitdéjeuner, je donne aussi à manger à Azizi.
